सी.बी.एस.ई. स्कूल होने के बाद भी डीपीएस रायपुर में हिंदी एक भाषा या विषय के रूप में नहीं अपितु संस्कार के रूप में पढ़ाई जाती है। समय-समय पर आयोजित होने वाली गतिविधियाँ छात्रों के भाषाई कौशलों को निखारने का सशक्त माध्यम हैं। छात्रों को साहित्यिक संस्कारों से जोड़ने के लिए विभिन्न गतिविधियों में भाग लेने के लिए प्रेरित किया जाता है। एक ओर जहाँ कविता वाचन, कहानी कथन, भाषण, समूह चर्चा आदि के माध्यम से उनके वाचन कौशल को धार देने का प्रयास किया जाता है तो वहीं दूसरी ओर निबंध लेखन, संवाद लेखन एवं विज्ञापन लेखन के माध्यम से उनके लेखन कौशल को निखारने की कोशिश की जाती है। हमारे छात्रों की इन आयोजनों में भागीदारी यह सिद्ध करती है कि अंग्रेजी भले ही उनकी शिक्षा का माध्यम है पर उनके संस्कारों की भाषा हिन्दी ही है। छात्रों के भाषाई विकास को दिशा देने के लिए विद्यालय में निम्नलिखित गतिविधियों का संचालन किया गया -

- कक्षा छठवीं से दसवीं तक के छात्रों ने महान उपन्यासकारों की प्रसिद्ध रचनाओं के पात्रों की आज के संदर्भ में प्रासंगिकता को समूह चर्चा के माध्यम से सिद्ध किया।

- हिन्दी वाद-विवाद समिति के मार्गदर्शन में नवमीं और दसवीं के छात्रों ने वाद-विवाद कौशल की बारीकियाँ समझीं और दिए गए विषय पर अपनी प्रस्तुति से अपनी वाककला का परिचय दिया।
- हिन्दी साहित्य के प्रति शिक्षकों का रुझान बढ़ाने के उद्देश्य से विभागीय शिक्षकों द्वारा एक कार्यशाला का आयोजन किया गया जिसमें हिन्दी के महान कथाकारों की कालजयी कृतियों के बारे में चर्चा की गई। विद्यालय के सभी शिक्षकों ने इन कृतियों को पढ़ने की प्रतिबद्धता दोहराई।
- 'वैश्विक सन्दर्भ और हिन्दी' कार्यशाला के माध्यम से छठवीं से आठवीं तक के विद्यार्थियों को विज्ञापन लेखन के टिप्स दिए गए। विद्यालय के प्राचार्य श्री रघुनाथ मुर्वजी इस कार्यशाला के मुख्य वक्ता थे।

STUPENDOUS AISCE AND AISSE RESULTS

Leaving a trail behind, with their stance, focus and the sacred endeavour to make 'possible the impossible' students of AISCE and AISSE of the School, were eulogized by all quarters for their incredible results declared in the month of April. The marvellous accomplishment is an evidence of their inner strength and character, enunciated by their unrivalled persistence.

Heralding their way to encrypt history was Spandan Pandey (Humanities) & Purvansh Bal (Science) who secured 97% to become icon & School Topper. Out of 144 students who appeared for AISSE from the school, 27% etched their profile as legends of the school with 90% plus aggregate, while 65% students secured 80% and above. Ishita Agrawal from Humanities stream scored 96.6%. Manasvi. B. Jain from Science & Samrat Jha from Humanities scored 96.2%.

In the AISSE, Riddhi Agrawal attested her élan and conviction by being bestowed with the top honors of 98.8% followed close at heels by Keshav Garg and Shambhavi Chandrakar with 98.6%. Siddhi Agrawal and Neha Kariya scored 98.4% and Kunal Basu scored 98.0%. Out of a total of 241 students who had appeared for the examination, 40% students scored above 90%, 68% students scored above 80% while 80% students scored above 75%. Remaining students scored 60% and above which reflects the true enterprising and industrious nature of the students and their teachers. True endeavours and endurance of the 19% students endorsing 95% and above defied all parameters.


