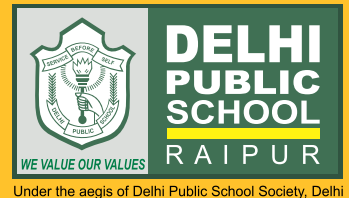


# International Vistas



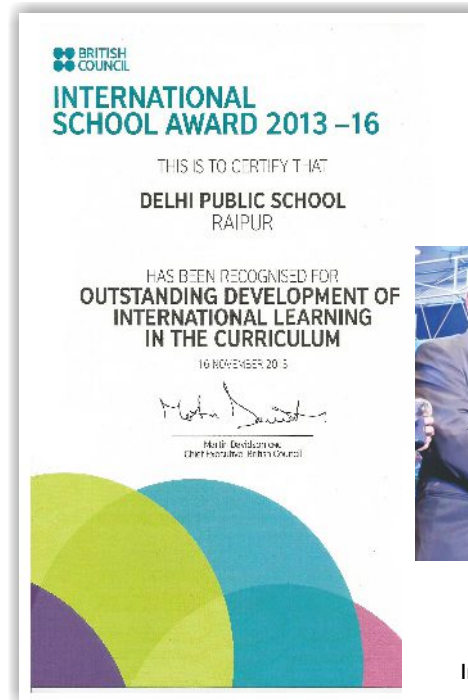

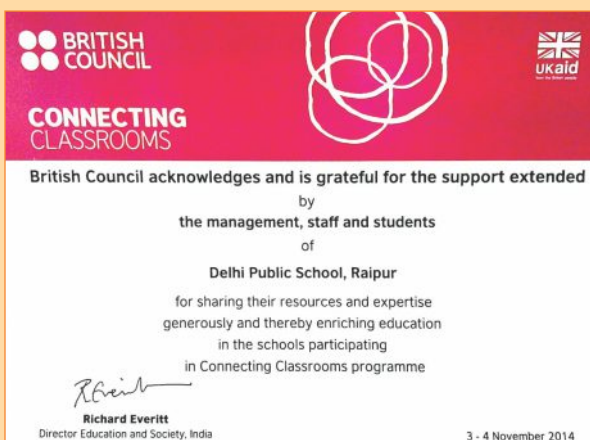
## Beginning with

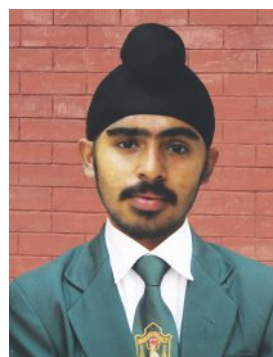
She is also awarded with Global Teacher Accreditation (GTA) for her action research in Biology by British Council and Cambridge Education, U.K.

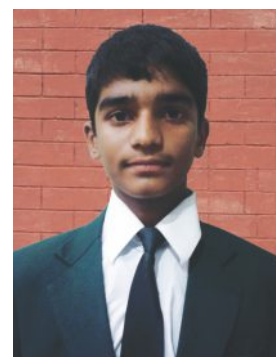

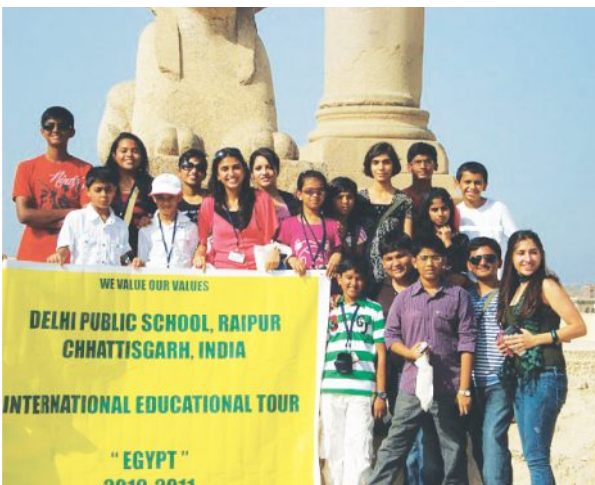

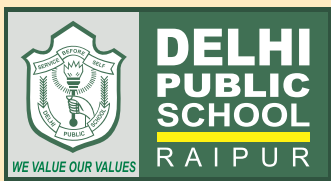
